

# Recommendations

Here we have provided some recommendations from our team on how to implement these lessons for your class. Please use this list as suggestions, as you are welcome to use our online lessons in the way that works best for you and your class.

**Video Order:** We recommend teachers and students watch the lesson videos in the order presented on our online lessons website, as each lesson builds on concepts from previous videos.

**Photo limit:** Provide a minimum and maximum number of photos for students to upload and edit for each lesson.

- We recommend students take 10-20 photos when taking their photos in nature for each lesson
- Then provide a maximum number of photos for students to upload and edit.
- We recommend each student shares between 2-5 photos for each lesson

**Organizing and sharing students' photos:** We recommend using a Google Photos Album to view, organize and share students' photos. Each student is able to upload their "Photo Challenge" photos easily from each lesson to one shared folder for the class and edit them.

- Students can also specify which lesson and challenge the photo was from, as well as "like" and comment on other students' photos in the class folder.

**Marking Check Ins:** Use the Check Ins as a learning tool, rather than a marking system. We encourage teachers to use the cumulative project at the end of the lessons as a summary of their learning, and a mark that can go towards the students' visual arts grade

**Photo privacy:** Have students turn off location data if they are using a cellphone to take photos

- Encourage students to only photograph nature and to not include photos of people with recognizable features (hands, feet, and shadows are permitted)
